On May 31, 2018 our Bylaws were approved by President Lonnie Stephenson. They are at the Printers being prepared for everyone, there are some changes to the Dues that will take Effect in your July Paychecks.

The Apprentice's dues will be based on a percent that corresponds to the year they are in the apprenticeship. (AP2 pays 2%, AP3 pays 3% and so on) There will be a refund issued to any apprentice who overpaid their working dues in June. The refund checks will be sent out sometime in August.

For everyone, there will be \$2.00 taken out of your Dues for Cope, we will be around looking for a new Cope card to be signed. You can still opt out of COPE, but this will not affect how much you pay in Dues, you will still pay the amount outlined in the bylaws.
