Section 3.03 No work shall be performed on Labor Day except in case of emergency and then only after permission of the Business Manager of the Union.

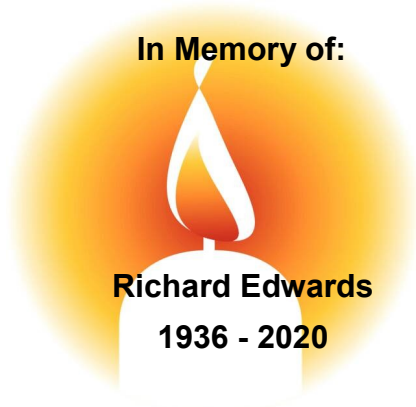
