Once you have the required hours and a passing exam result; you can turn in your application, with your check for \$25, to the City of Binghamton for the practical part of the test.

Due to a change in federal law, taxpayers are no longer required to submit an IRS Form 1095-B (which documents health insurance coverage) when filing their federal tax returns. As a result, the Funds Office will no longer mail the Form 1095-B to members.
